PROGRAM OVERVIEW & WEEKLY CLASS SCHEDULES

Program Overview

The classes offered below provide a leveled dance curriculum that allows your dancer to grow and progress through their dance education while basing their learning in technique. Our Little Ballet classes focus on body awareness, spatial awareness, rhythm, and musicality. Older students have the opportunity to continue their dance education with a deeper understanding of and exposure to rhythmic dance with our African dance classes. Additionally, older students may choose to take Jazz classes, which allow them to learn an art form created in America that combines the musicality of African dance with the technique of ballet.

Class Schedules

Class schedules are designed to help your dancer grow. All placement and promotions are at the sole discretion of the Directors and instructors.

Mandatory Uniform Requirements

BALLET

Girls (students who identify as she/her/hers)

All ballet students wear flesh tone convertibles tights and professional quality flesh tone ballet slippers along with the appropriate leotard color as specified below:

2-4 years (Little Ballet) - Pink (leotard, tights, & shoes)

5-7 years - Light Blue

8-11 years (Level I/II) - Dark Purple

8-11 years (Level II/III) - Red

12-18 years - Black

Boys (students who identify as he/him/his)

All male ballet students wear black convertibles tights or athletic pants and black professional quality ballet slippers along with a fitted white or black t-shirt.

HAIR

Hair must be neatly secured off of the face and neck, for Ballet preferably in a ballet bun. Small braids are welcome. Long, thick braids are not acceptable as they throw off the dancer's balance, do not remain secure on the head, or accent the neckline. Hair beads are also discouraged.

MODERN & CONTEMPORARY

All modern/contemporary students wear class color leotard, black convertible tights and bare feet.

JAZZ & TAP

All jazz and tap students wear black leotards, black convertible tights and black jazz and/or tap shoes.

HIP-HOP

T-shirt or tank top of choice, athletic bottoms and cleaned bottomed sneakers. Sneaker must not be worn outdoors

as to not track dirt and debris into the dance studio. Preferably black sneakers with white rubber soles (Converse style).

AFRICAN/AFROBEATS

Black leotards or shirts, black leggings or athletic pants, and bare feet. Lapas (African skirts) will be provided at the start of the season to be returned at the final rehearsal

PMDI Rules & Policies

Dress Code/Uniform

Each class has a mandatory dress code. Dancers are issued a verbal warning the first week they are without proper attire. The second week they will be sent a written warning to be returned signed by a parent. A third warning and the dancer will be asked to audit the class until the proper attire has been acquired. See Mandatory Uniform Requirements page for details. Students can leave additional dance attire at the studio if needed if this will assist in maintain this policy.

Studio Etiquette

Please arrive 10-15 minutes before class start time and change in the dressing rooms. Once dressed, prepare for class by stretching and warming up the body. Loud talking and disruptive behavior is not permitted in class. *No food, colored beverages, or street shoes are allowed in the dance studio.

Mobile Phones & Technology Policy

Mobile phone and Ipad use is not permitted while studying at the Princess Mhoon Dance Institute. Students may only use the phone to contact parents, research, find music, rehearsal video or for dance related reasons with special permission only. All devices that are abused at PMDI must be submitted to the administrative office during instruction time. Inappropriate use and social media posts will result in a conference with the Director and the entire family about the dangers of the internet and possible suspension depending on the severity of the matter.

Attendance & Punctuality Commitment

Weekly attendance is required. Poor attendance delays the learning process of the student and affects everyone in the class. Tardy students disturb punctual students and the instructor by interrupting the lesson. Students are more than welcome to sit in on classes if they are injured. Members who have more than three absences will be flagged for family conference and removal from performance opportunities or the program.

Missed Classes/Make-Ups

There are no make-ups for unexcused/ personal absences. If a student is seriously ill or injured, we will accept an official doctor's notice and offer up to 2 make-up classes per semester. Classes should be made up within two weeks of absence.

Refund Policy

There will be no refunds issued for the Fall/Spring dance sessions once classes begin.

This includes all classes, workshops, concerts, camps and PMDI paraphernalia. A credit will be issued to your account for unforeseen circumstances beyond your control.

Bullying

PMDI has a zero tolerance for bullying. Immediate intervention and investigation will take place if it occurs and the offender will be suspended and/or permanently removed if found guilty.

Tuition/Late

Tuition is automatically processed on the last Friday of every month. Declined funds, returned checks and late payments will receive a \$35.00 charge. PMDI has the right to refuse class participation for anyone that has not submitted payment. ACH and Auto-Debit opt-outs will incur a \$35 administrative fee.

Studio Closing/Inclement Weather

Studio closings will be posted on our website once the Director has made the decision to close. All studio closings are eligible for make-up classes during the make-up week only. You may also call and email the studio for an update.

Photo & Video Release

PMDI reserves the right to use all photos and videos taken on the premises or during off-site performances for marketing purposes. Objections to photo or video release must be submitted in writing to the studio. Parents cannot take video or photos without permission from instructor.

Insurance

All parents must have insurance coverage for their dancer(s).

Important Notes & Policies

All monthly payment plans are automatic withdrawal via a credit card on file, on the last Friday of each month for the following month's tuition.

For example: November tuition is charged October 27.

First and last months' tuition is paid upon enrollment and is non-refundable after classes have begun. Studio credits are available by request if your classes must be dropped.

Tuition does not include costume, performance and/or other additional fees assessed throughout the season.

Please note: Additional fees are an estimated \$200 each session per class. If monthly tuition is not paid by the dates below, we will assess a \$35 late fee (unless special payment arrangements are made).

Families with 3 or more children enrolled receive a 10% discount on tution.
